REGISTRATION: Late registration and packet pickup will take place beginning at 8:30 AM in the **Rotary Pavilion**. The course starts and ends in front of the Rotary Pavilion, where heated restrooms are available. Participants are urged to park near the Waterworks cookhouse and walk across the pathway between the ponds or in the Cabin #3 area, as parking will be restricted in front of the pavilion where the start/finish lines are located. The race will be held regardless of the weather unless Presque Isle State Park is closed by park authorities. If the park is closed the race will be cancelled and not rescheduled. If weather is questionable, check the message at 814-460-9930.

PREMIUM: Each runner/walker will receive a gift-boxed set of two stemless glasses imprinted with the race logo. Premiums are ONLY GUARANTEED to the first 150 registered runners/walkers so YOU ARE URGED TO PRE-REGISTER!! A special short-sleeve shirt is available for an additional \$12 as a menu item. You must register by December 1 to be guaranteed delivery of the shirt on race day.

AWARDS: Awards will be awarded to the first overall male and female, and to the top two finishers in the following age groups for both male and female: 19 & under, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, and 70 & over. There are no separate awards for the walk.

RACE PREMIUM: All pre-registered participants will receive an ERC 2023 desk calendar and a drawstring tote bag. You may also choose to order the special menu item – a 58" Vented Auto-open Folding Golf Umbrella. Umbrellas will be guaranteed on race day to the first 120 orders. If necessary, an additional order will be placed, but only the first 120 are guaranteed!

Awards will be presented to the top male and female walkers overall and the top 3 males and females in these divisions: 19 & under, 20-49, and 50 & over.*

<u>NOTE:</u> The race will take place as scheduled regardless of the weather, with one exception: <u>the race may be</u> <u>postponed or cancelled altogether if Presque Isle State Park is closed by park authorities for any reason</u>. Since this is always a possibility, call 814-460-9930 if you have any doubt about the race being held.
